God wants you to live a life free of stress. He gives you daily grace provisions and wonderful promises for this lifestyle. The Bible contains over 7,000 promises from God. I encourage you to learn some so you can stand on them.

Standing on God's promises is how you develop trust in God. As your trust and knowledge of God grow, you will realize the Christian way of life is an amazing way to live.

We call standing on the promises of God using faith-rest. When you faith-rest a situation, you focus on God and His provisions. God's promises are your shield of faith to protect you from the strategies of the devil and human viewpoint thinking.

Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil ... In addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish the flaming arrows of the evil one. (Ephesians 6:10-16)

Let's start off with God's promise of salvation, *Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved (Acts 16:31)*. If you have not made the decision yet on where you will spend eternity, do not wait another moment. In prayer, tell God the Father, "I believe your Son Jesus Christ died on the cross for me. I accept Him as my Savior." By this simple act of faith, God gives you eternal life.

To use a promise within your shield of faith, first, be sure you are filled with the Holy Spirit. This means you have no unconfessed sin in your life because you have used God's provision to handle personal sin, *If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).*

Next, recall a promise from those you have memorized and stored in your soul. If the situation and time allow, you can select one from your "Go To" list or a resource such as this book.

Then, claim the promise by expressing your thoughts to God the Father in prayer, reciting His promise to you. Thank Him for giving you this promise.

This is where God's promise of the ministry of the Holy Spirit takes effect. The Holy Spirit will help you recall relevant Biblical principles you have learned. Now you have sound options to consider.

The final step is to mix your faith in God and His promise with a Biblical rationale, come to a conclusion, and apply it as you persevere through your circumstance.

I pray you will find this compilation of God's promises useful as you advance in your spiritual life.

SALVATION

Acts 16:31 Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved.

1 Corinthians 15:21-22 For since by man [Adam] came death, by Man [Jesus Christ] came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all will be made alive.

2 Corinthians 5:17 If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things have passed away and all things have become new.

Isaiah 41:10 Do not fear, for I am with you; do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

Isaiah 41:13 For I, the Lord your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, 'Fear not, I will help you.'

Jeremiah 17:7-8 Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord and whose trust is the Lord. For he will be like a tree planted by the water that extends its roots by a stream and will not fear when the heat comes; but its leaves will be green and it will not be anxious in a year of drought nor cease to yield fruit.

John 14:26-27 The Mentor, the Holy Spirit, will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you. Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled nor let it be fearful.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you that in Me you might have peace. In the world you are going to have tribulation but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

Joshua 1:9 Be strong and courageous. Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.

Luke 1:37 For nothing will be impossible with God.

Matthew 6:25-27 I tell you do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink, or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothes? Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? Can any of you, by worrying, add a single hour to your life?

Matthew 6:34 Do not worry about tomorrow for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Matthew 10:28 Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Numbers 14:18 The Lord is slow to anger and abounding in love, forgiving sin and rebellion; yet He does not leave the guilty unpunished.

1 Peter 2:15 For such is the will of God that by doing right you may silence the ignorance of foolish men.

1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.

Philippians 4:6-7 Stop worrying, but in everything by prayer with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God which surpasses all comprehension will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Proverbs 3:24 When you lie down, you will not be afraid; yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet.

Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You.

Psalm 62:5 My soul waits patiently for God. My patience comes from Him both now and throughout eternity.

Psalm 71:5 For You are my hope, O Lord God; You are my confidence from my youth.

Psalm 94:19 In the multitude of my anxieties within me, Your comforts delight my soul.

Psalm 118:6 The Lord is for me, I will not fear; what can man do to me?

Revelation 2:10 Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer ... Be faithful until death and I will give you the crown of life.

Romans 10:17 Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 In everything give thanks for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:7 God has not given us a lifestyle of fear, but of power and of love and of sound judgment.

2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord will deliver me from every evil work and preserve me for His heavenly kingdom.

Psalms 3:3 You, O Lord, are a shield about me, My glory, and the One who lifts my head.

Psalm 91:4 He will cover you with His pinions, and under His wings you should take refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

2 Corinthians 4:16-18 We are not discouraged, for though our outer man is decaying our inner man is being renewed day by day. For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith not by sight.

Ephesians 4:23 Become refreshed through the agency of the Holy Spirit by means of your thinking.

Hebrews 12:2 Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Isaiah 40:31 Those who wait for the Lord will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary.

Isaiah 46:4 For even to your old age I will be the same and even to your graying years I will carry you! I made you and I will sustain you. I will deliver you.

Job 12:12 Is not wisdom found among the aged? Does not long life bring understanding?

John 10:10 I have come that they may have life and have it more abundantly.

John 14:16-17 I [Christ] will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper [Holy Spirit], that He may be with you forever... He abides with you and will be in you.

John 15:11 These things I have spoken to you that My happiness may be in you and that your happiness may be full.

Psalm 23:3 He restores my soul; He guides me in the wagon tracks of righteousness because of His integrity.

Psalm 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people whom He has chosen for His own inheritance.

Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him and He will do it.

Psalm 43:3 Send out Your light and Your truth, let them lead me.

Psalm 56:11 In God I have put my trust, I shall not be afraid. What can man do to me?

Psalm 73:24 You will guide me with Your word in my soul, and afterward take me up to glory.

Psalm 90:12 Teach us to organize our days that we may attain a heart of wisdom.

Psalm 91:11-12 He will give His angels charge concerning you, to guard you in all your ways. They will bear you up in their hands that you do not strike your foot against a stone.

COMFORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT

Psalm 119:165 Those who love Your word have great peace and nothing causes them to stumble.

Psalm 136:1 Give thanks to the Lord for His mercy endures forever.

Psalm 139:5 You have enclosed me behind and before, and laid Your hand upon me.

Psalm 147:3 God heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Romans 5:3-5 We also glory in tribulations knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 8:31 If God is for us, who is against us?

Romans 12:2-3 Stop being conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind ... Think with sound judgment as God has assigned to each one of us a standard of thinking from His Word.

Romans 12:12 Rejoice in hope, endure in affliction, persevere in prayer.

Romans 15:4 For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build up each other.

1 Thessalonians 5:24 He who calls you is faithful, who will also do it.

DYING GRACE

Acts 20:24 Nor do I consider my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.

1 Corinthians 10:31 Whatever you do, do it all to the glory of God.

1 Corinthians 15:36 That which you sow does not come to life unless it dies.

1 Corinthians 15:53-54 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. Then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory.'

1 Corinthians 15:55 O death, where is your sting? O death, where is your victory?

2 Corinthians 5:6-8 Knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord; for we walk by faith, not by sight; we are of good courage and prefer to be absent from the body and face to face with the Lord.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-2 There is an appointed time for everything, a time for every purpose under heaven: a time to be born and a time to die.

Ephesians 2:7 So that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us.

Isaiah 30:18 Therefore the Lord longs to be gracious to you, and therefore He waits on high to have compassion on you. For the Lord is a God of justice; how blessed are all those who long for Him.

James 4:14 You do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away.

DYING GRACE

Job 5:26 You will come to the grave at a full age, as a sheaf of grain ripens in its season.

Philippians 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and absolute confidence that I shall not be put to shame in anything but that with all boldness, Christ shall even now, as always, be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.

Philippians 1:21 To live is Christ, to die is gain.

Psalms 23:4 Even though I walk through the death-shadowed valley, I will not fear harm, for You walk with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

Psalms 34:22 The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, and none of those who trust in Him will be forsaken.

Psalms 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Psalms 116:15 Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints.

Revelation 14:13 Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord.

Romans 14:8 If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord. Therefore, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.

2 Timothy 4:6-8 The time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness which the Lord will award me.

ETERNAL SECURITY

Colossians 1:5 For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, of which you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel.

Colossians 3:23-24 Whatever you do, do it heartily as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance, for you serve the Lord Christ.

1 Corinthians 13:12 Now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face-to-face; now I know in part, but then I will know fully.

1 Corinthians 15:42-44 So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown a perishable body, it is raised an imperishable body; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.

Galatians 5:1 It is for freedom that Christ has set us free.

Isaiah 64:4 The eye has not seen, the ear has not heard, the heart has never known the amazing things God has waiting for you.

John 10:28 I give eternal life to them and they will never perish; and no one can snatch them out of My hand.

John 14:2-3 I go to prepare a place for you, and if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also.

1 John 2:25 This is the promise which He Himself made to us, eternal life.

1 Peter 1:3-5 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is incorruptible and undefiled, that fades not away, reserved in heaven for us who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

ETERNAL SECURITY

Philippians 3:10 That I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His suffering.

Revelation 21:4 God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain, for the former things are passed away.

Romans 8:11 He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through the Holy Spirit who dwells in you.

Romans 8:38-39 I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, will be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Samuel 12:22-23 He [David] said, "While my infant son was still alive I fasted and wept; for I said, 'Who knows whether the Lord will be gracious to me that my child may live?' But now that he has died, why should I fast? Can I bring him back? [No.] I will go to him [in heaven], he will not return to me."

1 Thessalonians 4:13-14 Do not grieve as those who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus Christ died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who through Jesus Christ sleep.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 The Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.

2 Timothy 2:13 Even if we become faithless, God remains faithful because He cannot deny Himself.

PRINCIPLES

Adversity is inevitable. Stress is optional.

Adversity is what life does to you. Stress is what you do to yourself.

Are you a risk taker or an excuse maker?

Arrogance: Self-justification leads to self-deception followed by self-absorption ending with self-destruction.

Arrogance reacts. Humility responds.

Articulate, don't speculate.

As goes your spiritual life, so goes the future of your nation.

As long as you are still alive, God has a plan for you.

Authority is not always fair, neither is life.

Bad decisions limit future options.

Be a spiritual quiet professional.

Be laconic.

Be patient and persistent in prayer.

Blessings come and blessings go, the Source remains the same.

Christianity is a personal relationship with God.

Circumstances in life are your pulpit, use them to glorify God.

Contentment comes from sharing the happiness of God, it brings capacity for life, love and happiness.

Counsel yourself with the Word of God in your soul.

PRINCIPLES

Divine discipline is intended to get your attention.

Don't bend to the demands of the world and don't blend God's Word to meet your desires.

Don't humanize God.

Don't try to make money off God.

Doubt is the absence of faith.

Emotionalism leads to faulty thinking.

Essential or non-essential? Evaluate distractions to your spiritual life.

Every problem has a solution stated in the Bible.

Faith is spiritual stamina.

Fear and your spiritual life are not compatible.

Fear of dying inhibits living.

Fear sees the problem. Faith sees the solution.

FLOT - A FLOT line in your soul keeps the outside sources of adversity from becoming the inside source of stress in your soul.

Get your eyes off self and on Christ.

God answers prayers in His timing, not yours.

God calls us to be witnesses, not lawyers. His Word can defend itself.

God designed you to think, not emote.

PRINCIPLES

God gave you two ends - one to think with and one to sit on.
Success in life depends on which end you use. Heads you win.
Tails you lose.

God uses prepared Christians.

God wants you to be faithful not flawless.

God will never throw you under the bus.

God's direction may take you where you don't want to go.

God's plan is perfect and His timing is perfect.

Grace is God's policy. Grace is God doing all the work.

Grace is neither earned nor deserved.

Gritching doesn't glorify the Lord.

Growing old is inevitable. Growing up is optional.

Happiness does not depend on people or circumstances.

Happiness is a state of mind.

Have an attitude of gratitude.

Having money just gives you the ability to be miserable in a
different part of town.

Holding on to the past is a waste of time.

How do you handle unfair situations? Do you respond with
humility or react with arrogance?

Human helplessness versus divine enablement.

PRINCIPLES

Human solutions are no solutions. Divine solutions are the only solutions.

Human viewpoint thinking is stinkin' thinkin'.

Humility is teachability.

If God is in it, He will pay for it.

If Satan can influence your thoughts, he can control you.

If you are not advancing you are regressing.

If you attend a church where the song service is longer than the teaching of God's Word, you're getting gypped.

If you don't arm your soul with the Word of God, you are a sitting duck in the angelic conflict.

If you live poorly in your soul you will die poorly.

In living, you apply God's Word; in dying, you live it.

It's easier to get yourself into trouble than to think your way out of trouble.

It's never too late to make a course correction in life.

It's never too late to rebound, reconsider your ways or relocate to get under the teaching of a qualified pastor.

Jesus Christ controls history.

Jesus Christ's mentality and intentionality are critical for you. His mentality, what He thought. His intentionality, what He did. Your spiritual life = what you think and what you do.

PRINCIPLES

Keep these three aligned in your life: the Witness of God's Word, the Witness of Circumstances and the Witness of the Holy Spirit.

LAG - Learn, Apply the Word of God and Glorify Jesus Christ.

Learn to live; don't live to learn.

Leave your agenda behind and walk into God's plan for your life.

Life is a journey, God's Word is the guide.

Live life in the light of eternity.

Love for God encourages.

Man looks on the outside, God looks on the inside.

Many people spend money they don't have, to buy things they don't need, to impress people they don't even like.

Most suffering is self-induced - we mismanage our money, we mismanage our health, we mismanage our relationships.

MVP – A spiritual MVP has momentum, virtue and poise. Momentum from hearing and keeping God's Word on a daily basis. Virtue from discernment, discretion and insight from divine wisdom. Poise from the ability to think under pressure.

Never build your happiness on someone else's unhappiness.

Never make a critical decision without considering God's will. He will guide you.

NICE. Name your sin to God the Father. Isolate it. Clear your conscience. Move on in Executing your spiritual life.

Objective optimism is a characteristic of resiliency.

PRINCIPLES

Once saved – Always saved.

Only God's Word helps others, not sharing your personal tragedies.

Passion or Priority? Put your priorities ahead of your passions.

Patience is a learned character asset.

People with OPD's (obnoxious personality disorders) can be the source of people testing - respond with impersonal love.

Prioritize your relationship with God over your relationships with people.

Production is a result of spiritual advancement, not the cause.

Protocol means doing a right thing in a right way.

Redeem the time. Tomorrow is not guaranteed.

Resiliency is the ability to adapt, orient and adjust.

Respond to divine discipline, let it lead you back to God's plan.

Right thinking leads to right motives and right actions.

Ritual without reality is meaningless.

Satan never quits. The cosmic system never rests.

Scripture gives you the ability to see the unknown.

Seize opportunities to present the Gospel.

Spiritual skills are acquired, not inherited.

Spiritual skills must precede production skills.

PRINCIPLES

Spirituality is an absolute. You are either filled with the Holy Spirit or under control of your sin nature. Spiritual maturity is relative and based on the filling of the Holy Spirit and the content of the Word of God in your soul.

Stay off the My Way Highway.

Stay out of activism.

Stick with the truth. Don't be recruited by the cosmic system.

Store up treasures from the Word of God in your soul, this will make you rich.

Subjectivity leads to negative volition and the arrogance of self-pity and self-absorption.

Testing can build spiritual muscle by how you respond.

Testing gives you data to assess your spiritual condition.

Testing is a means to an end, it gets you where you need to go.

Testing often comes in your area of weakness.

The Bible is not a novel; it is a textbook. God designed it to be taught by a qualified pastor.

The choices you make determine the life you lead.

The Christian way of life is not activity or productivity, it is conductivity. We are transmitters of God's grace.

The Fantastic Four (Proverbs 2:10-11):
Wisdom. Knowledge. Discretion. Understanding.

The Lord delivers you through adversity, not necessarily from adversity.

PRINCIPLES

The peace of God is reflected in your life by tranquility.

The prevailing power of persistent prayer.

The public lie is to tell it often enough and loud enough and people will believe it.

The rate of learning must exceed the rate of forgetting.

The spiritual life is a process.

The Supreme Court of Heaven is open 24/7. Let God handle the justice, He has all the facts.

The will of God will never lead you to where the grace of God can't protect you.

The Word of God gives you comfort in the moment and an anticipation of the joy to come tomorrow.

The Word of God is a mirror reflecting your life back to you.

The Word of God is a sedative for anxiety.

There are no accidents in the plan of God.

There is no adversity too great for the plan of God.

There is no room for personal sentimentality in the Christian way of life.

There is no shortcut to learning the Word of God.

There is real danger in experimenting with things the world offers.

Think grace and demonstrate grace.

PRINCIPLES

Three checkpoints for knowing the directive will of God: Where does God want me to be? What does God want me to think? What does God want me to do?

Time doesn't shout, it just runs out, sooner than you think.

Today we have too many preacher-performers and not enough pastor-teachers.

Treat people based on your character and integrity, not theirs.

Unhappy people take their unhappiness with them wherever they go.

Use Scripture. It worked for the Lord Jesus Christ, it will work for you.

Wait on God's timing; don't be impetuous.

What God thinks of you is what counts, not the opinions of others.

What impresses people is what's in your soul.

When you don't have enough on the inside to offset the pressures from the outside, you will be crushed.

Where do you get your direction in life - from the Word of God or from your friends?

Winners execute. Losers emote.

WOJ's (weird obnoxious jerks) - respond with impersonal love.

Worry is assuming unassigned responsibilities.

You are a divinely appointed influencer.

PRINCIPLES

You are either serving God or you are serving Satan at any given moment.

You are never alone.

You are never too old to stop learning.

You are not called to clean up the devil's world; you are called to re-present Jesus Christ.

You are the product of your decisions.

You are the victim of your decisions, not your circumstances.

You are what you think, not what you think you are.

You trust God with your life, trust Him with the details.

You can't apply what you don't know.

You can't know the will of God apart from the Word of God.

You don't have to tell God your problems, thank Him for the solutions.

You have total control over the development of your soul.

Your soul never grows old.

Your spiritual gift is given by God to serve Him; your talent is different.

Your spiritual life is defined by self-discipline and refined by testing.

Your spiritual life is lived in your thoughts.
